International trade is the exchange of goods and services between countries. Countries trade in different resources such as food. Food is traded because not all countries have the correct climate or growing conditions for a wide range of food. In addition to this, countries trade in natural resources because they occur in certain parts of the world and countries can make money from selling resources to other countries. The exchange of goods by trade links changes the dynamics of a community.
