## **Year 11 Masterclasses and Conference – 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> January 2022**

Dear Parents & Year 11 Students,

As you have already been informed, Year 11 students will now be tested, following the Christmas break, on Thursday 6<sup>th</sup> January from 8.30am. This will enable us to provide some additional lessons for Year 11 on Thursday 6<sup>th</sup> and Friday 7<sup>th</sup> January.

Following the Mock Examinations and the feedback from parents' evening, we will be holding master classes on Thursday 6<sup>th</sup> January for students who study I-Media and Sports Studies, please see the details below.

On Friday 7<sup>th</sup> January, all Year 11 students will attend a year 11 conference in science and their option subjects. This is a fantastic opportunity for students to get in-depth support for each of their option subjects and their science GCSEs. **Thursday 6<sup>th</sup> January** Students that have agreed to a lateral flow test should arrive at Talbot Gate for **08.30am** and go straight to the Sports Hall. Students that have not consented to the lateral flow test should arrive to Talbot Gate for **09.00am** and go straight to the Year 11 work zone. Master classes will start from **09.15am** and finish at **11.15am**.
